



Occupational Health and Safety Policy

Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 - Section 2

T.I. Protective Coatings will control its activities to avoid causing unnecessary or unacceptable risk to the safety and health of all employees, visitors, temporary workers and the general public.

The objects of this policy are:

6. Establish and maintain measurable objectives and targets for safety performance and regular review of these objectives.
7. Commitment to continual improvement of the health & safety management system.
8. Ensuring that this policy is communicated and understood at all levels throughout the organisation
